Competitors arrived from Budapest, Kecskemét, Békéscsaba, Vecsés, Szekszárd, Enying and Horgos in Serbia.

The hosts also provided continuous hospitality, so the competition was really pleasant and family-like. The winners and runners-up received cup and medal prizes at the announcement of the results.
